Central Fire will be hosting a county wide disaster drill exercise on April 20<sup>th</sup> in the Mountain Ranch area. Multiple county and state agencies will be participating in this drill that will help ensure that Calaveras County is prepared for a disaster.

The Firefighter's Association will be holding a Rummage Sale / fundraiser at Station 3 in Mountain Ranch on Friday May 3<sup>rd</sup> and Saturday 4<sup>th</sup>.

The Fire Chief will be attending an Advanced EMT First Response Workshop in Modesto on January 24<sup>th</sup>. Board members are invited to attend to learn more about how Advanced EMTs could provide a higher level of emergency medical services for Central Fire's residents.

- Insulate your walls and attics; caulk and weather-strip doors and windows.

- Repair roof leaks and cut away tree branches that could fall on the house.
- Wrap pipes in your basement or crawl spaces with foam insulators; consider a water heater blanket.
- If you have a fireplace, keep the flue closed when you're not using it. Make sure your fireplace has been cleaned and properly maintained before use. Make sure flammable materials are cleared away from the fireplace before use.
- Make sure your furniture isn't blocking your heating vents.

## For your car

Winter weather conditions can make driving hazardous. It's important to be prepared if you're in your car when a disaster occurs. When the temperatures start to drop, make sure these parts of your car are in tip-top shape:

- Make sure your antifreeze, windshield wiper fluid, gas tank, oil and other fluids are full
- Make sure your tires have enough tread; make sure you have properly fitting chains in your vehicle and know how to install them.
- Before you drive, do a good job of clearing snow off the top of the car, the headlights and the windows.
- Add your auto club, insurance agent or towing service phone numbers to your cell phone.
- Keep a cold-weather kit in your trunk that includes blankets, snacks, a first aid kit and a flashlight.

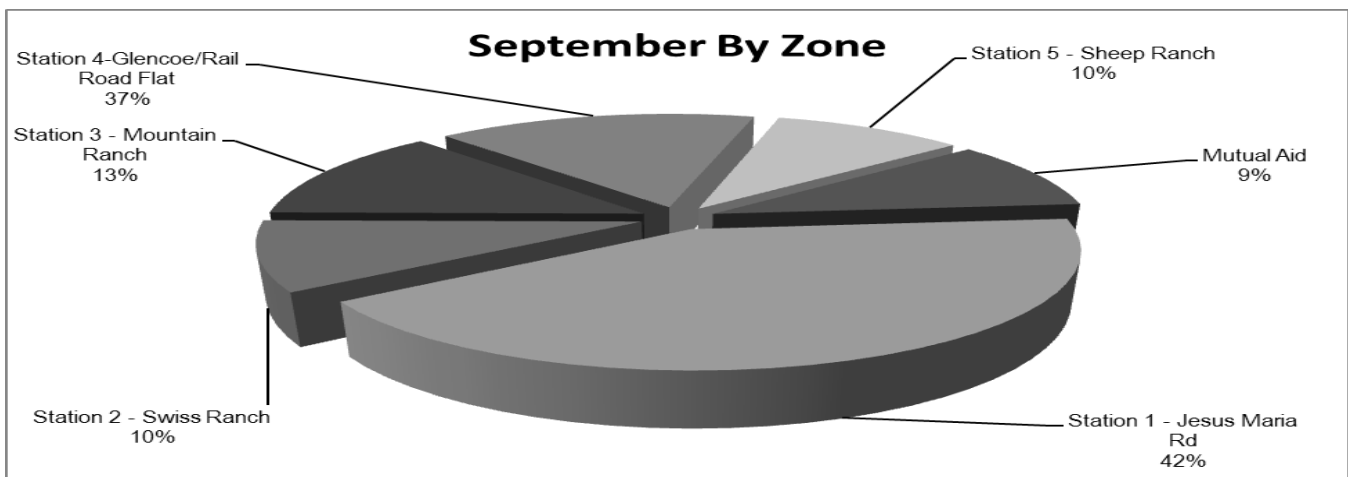
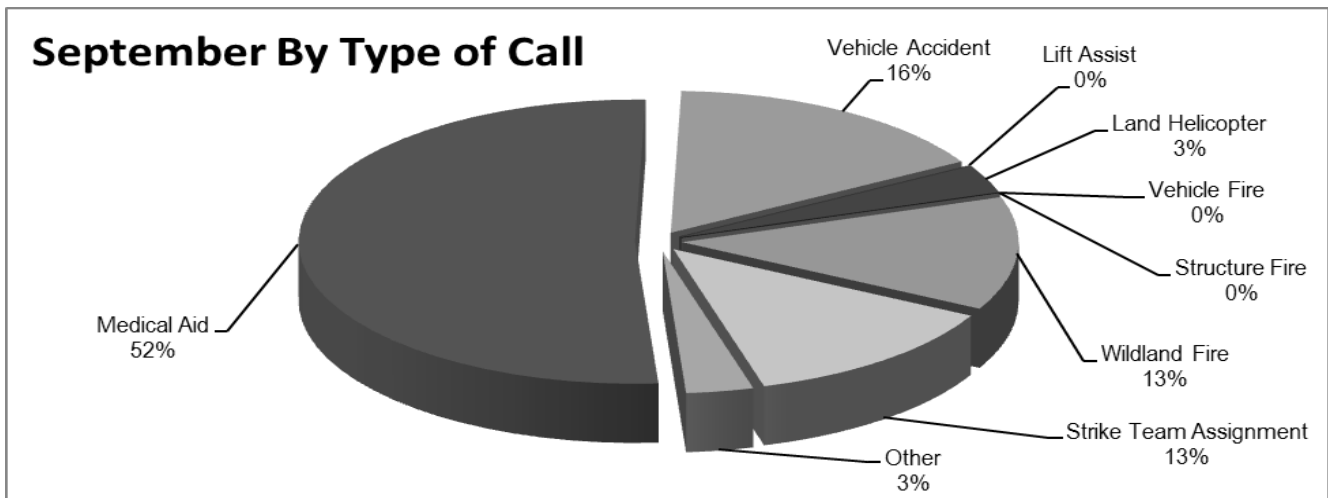

CERT (Calaveras Emergency Response Team): The Calaveras Fire Chief's Association and the Calaveras Citizen's Corp Council has entered into a memorandum of Agreement where the Citizen's Corp Council will coordinate and provide oversight of Calaveras County's CERT teams and the Chief's Association will act as a central point for disseminating information for the Fire Agencies in the County. Each Fire District will maintain control of the day to day operations of their CERT teams, but in the event of a County wide disaster will be able to call upon a coordinated group of volunteers from neighboring agencies to assist.

On September 22<sup>nd</sup>, the American Red Cross conducted a disaster shelter exercise in San Andreas. Many of our local Mountain Ranch Red Cross volunteers participated. This very successful exercise demonstrates the benefit of preparation and training that our local Red Cross and CERT volunteers have put forth over the last several years. Central Fire will be hosting a Community Disaster drill in April to further enhance Emergency Preparedness for Calaveras County.

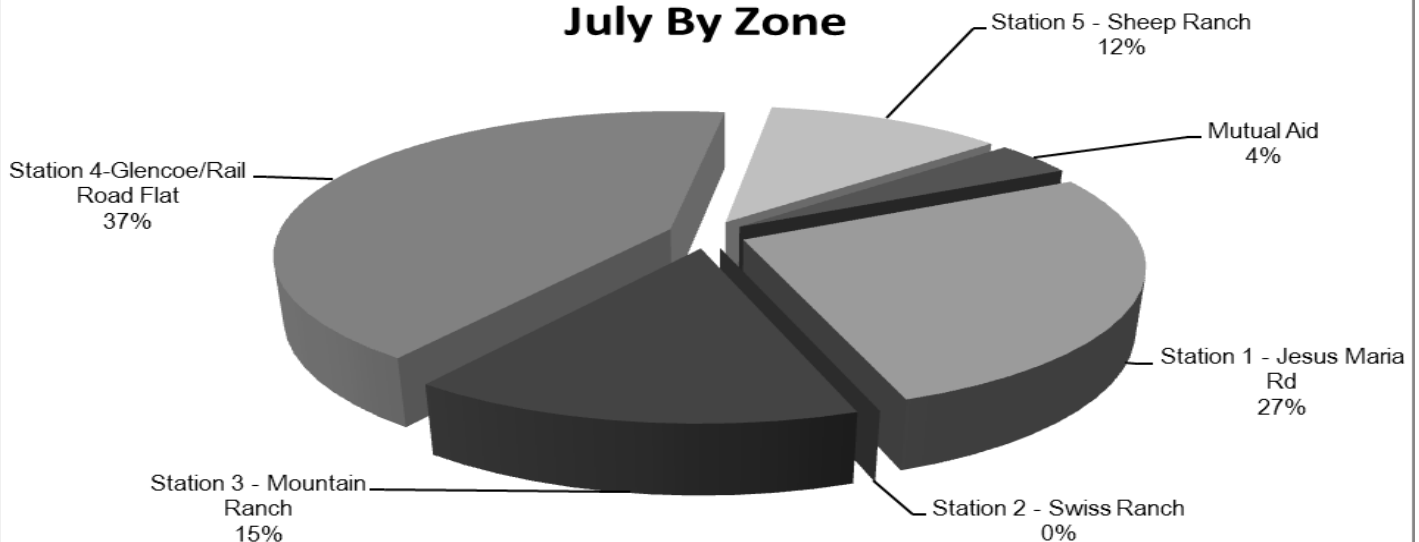

**SAFER GRANT:** The Calaveras County Fire Chief's Association has been awarded nearly \$1.9 Million under the Federal Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response Grant for the Recruitment and Retention of Volunteer Firefighters. The grant will be used to increase the number of Volunteer Firefighters in Calaveras County. Central Fire will be able to use this grant to offer a "cafeteria style" benefit plan to current and future Volunteer Firefighters, Volunteer Emergency Medical Responders, and Volunteer Water Tender Operators. Benefits include supplemental insurance, childcare expenses, tuition assistance, or retirement benefits such as a 401k plan.

**Day In The Park:** August 25<sup>th</sup> Central Fire and the Firefighters Association will be participating in the Mountain Ranch Day in the Park. Central Fire will be recruiting new volunteers and educating the community on what we do, how community members can be Fire Safe, including helping make sure that everyone has a well-marked address sign, and promoting the availability of Central Fire's new Safe Kids Child Safety Seat Program providing free installation and training on the proper use of child safety seats. 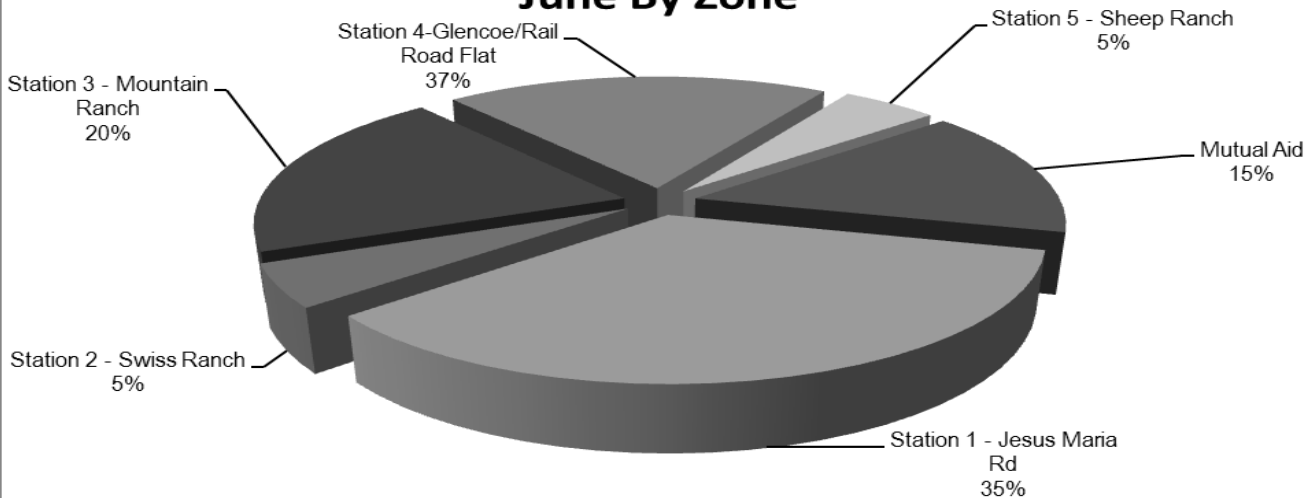

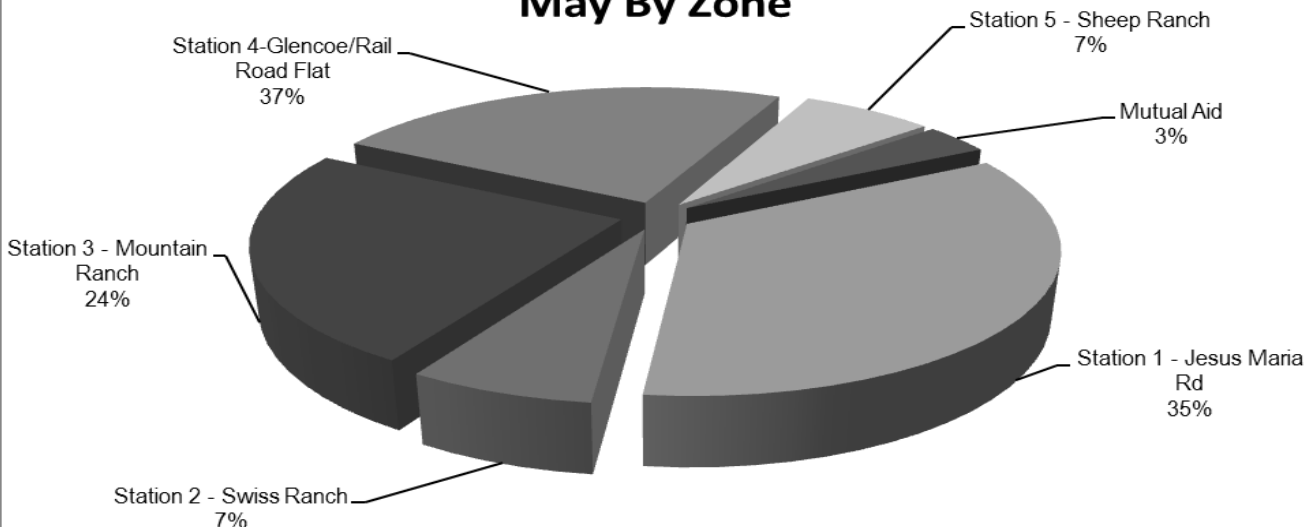

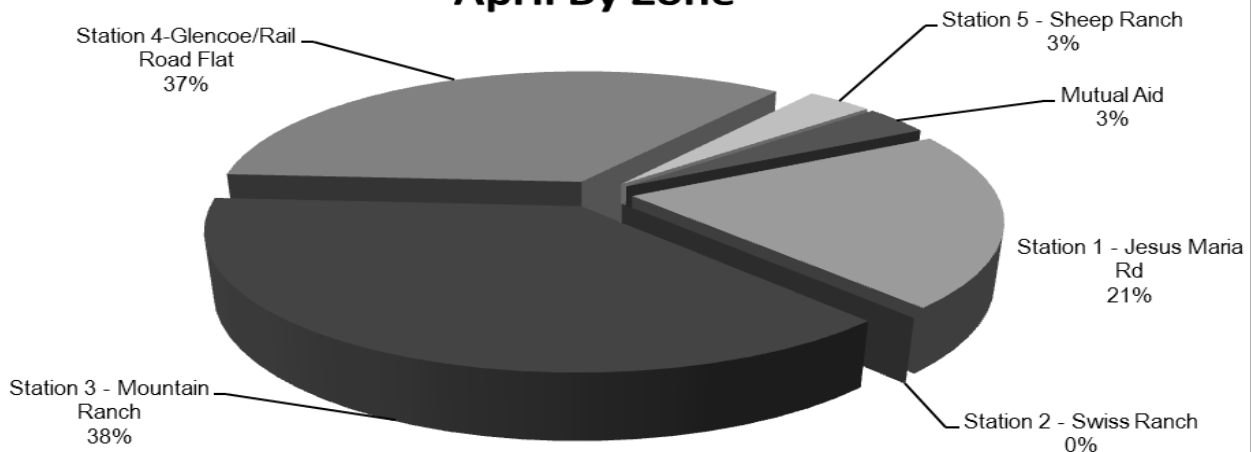
